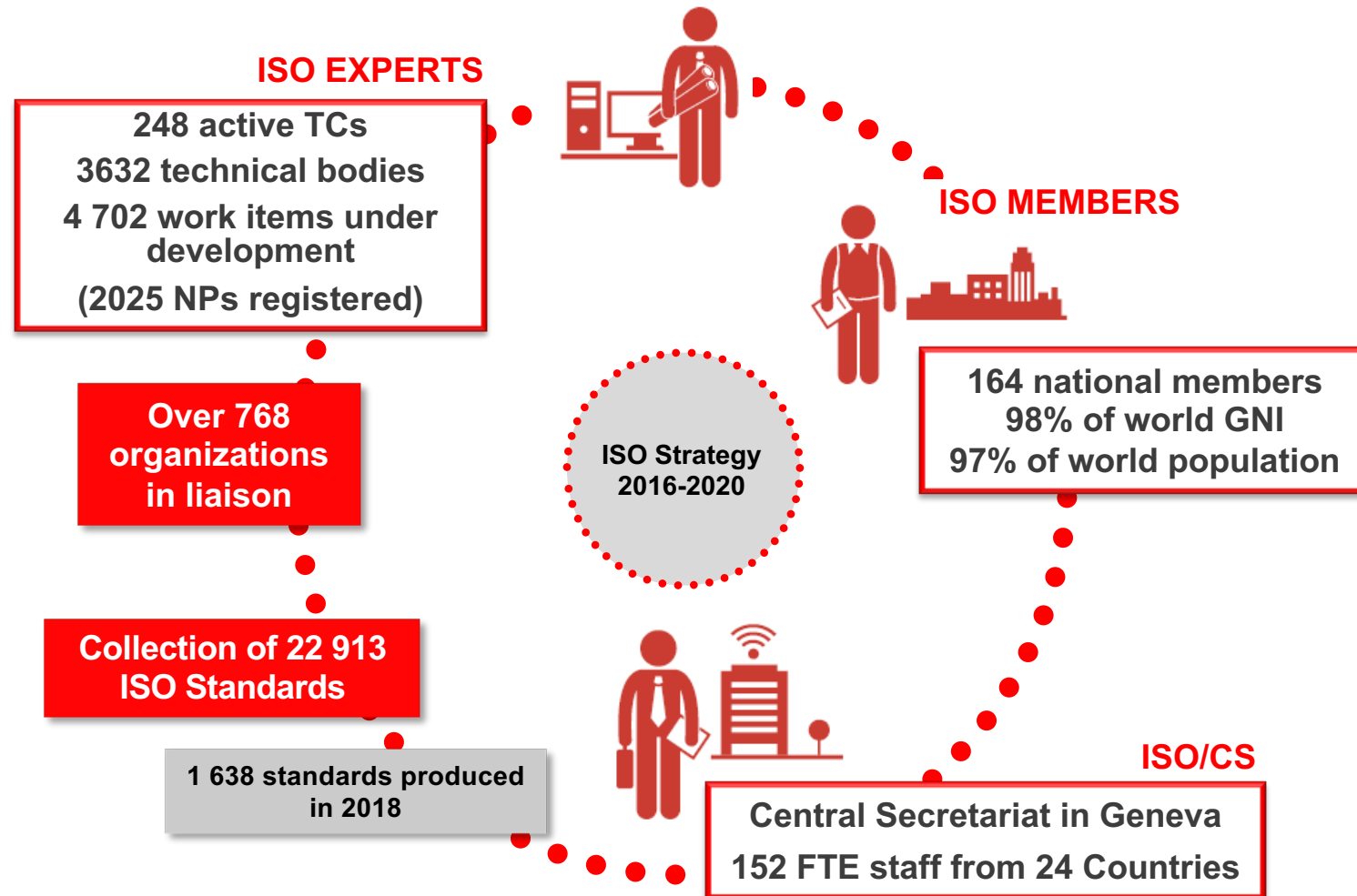

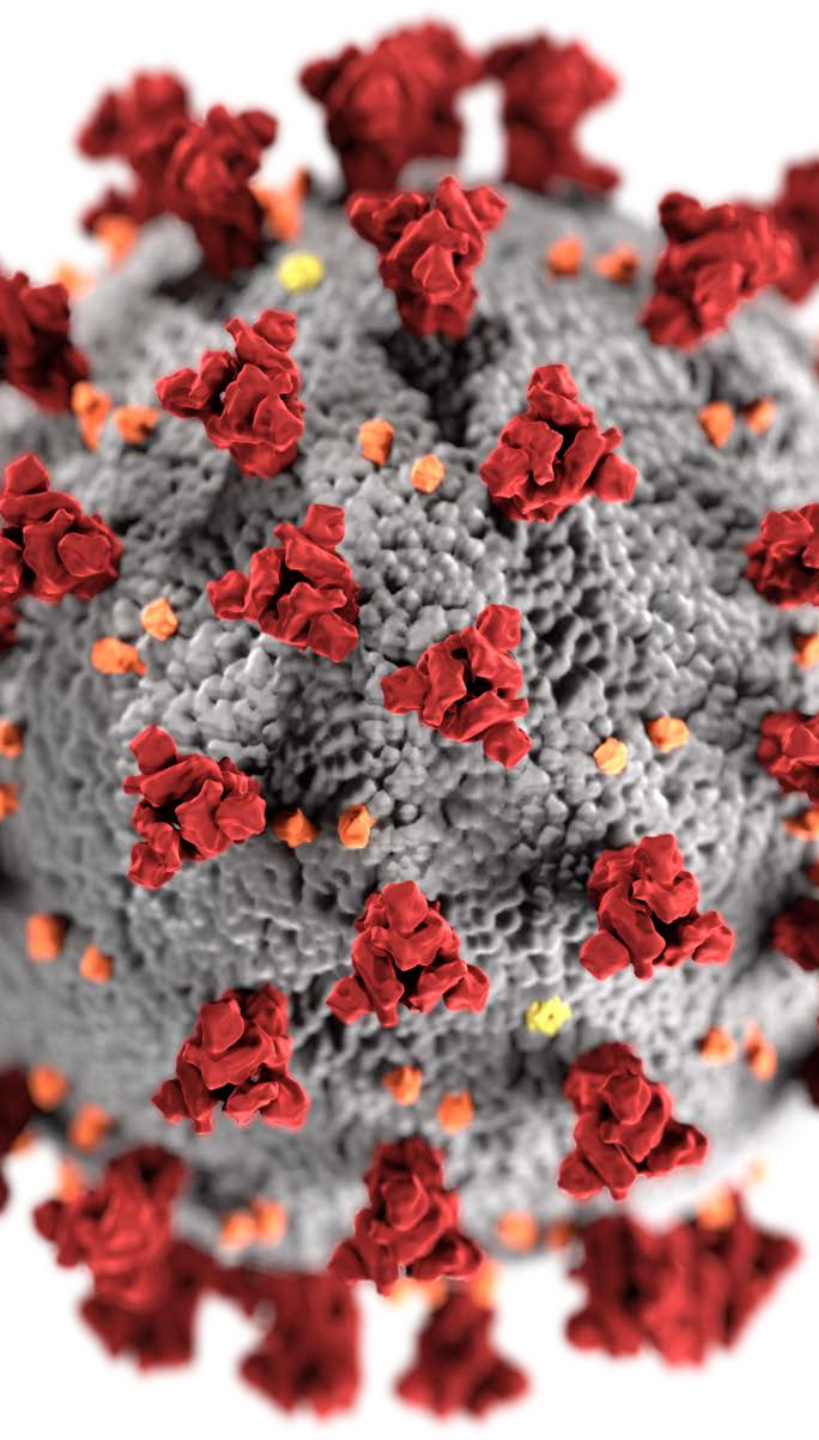

11.7 By 2030, provide universal access to **safe, inclusive and accessible, green and public spaces, in particular for women and children, older persons and persons with disabilities**

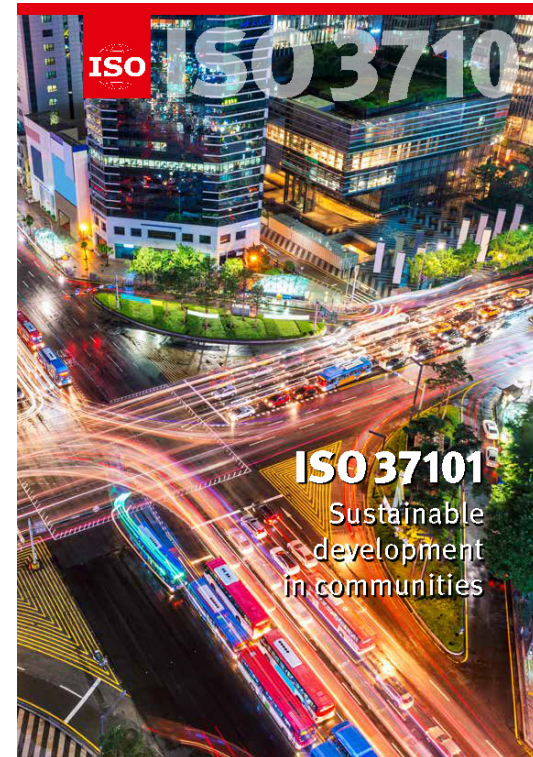

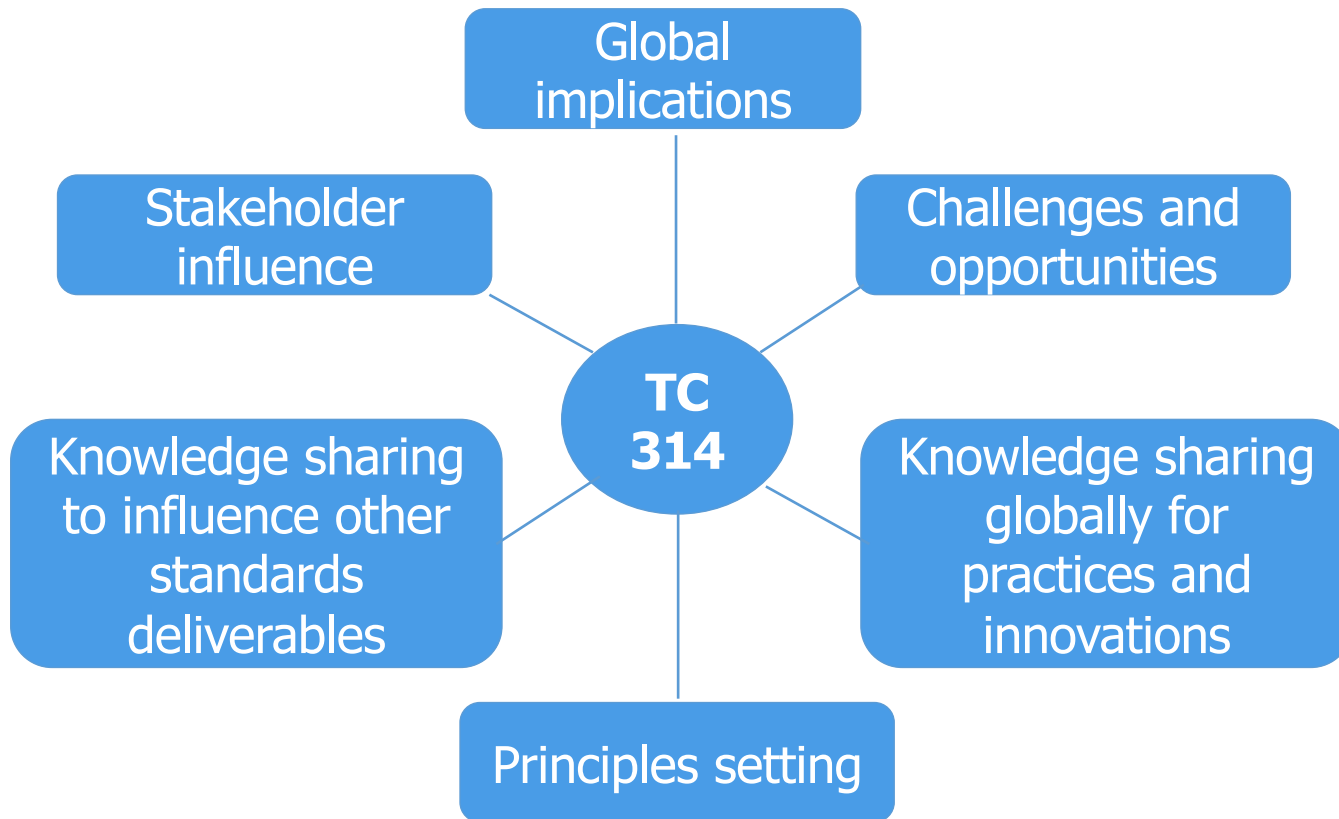

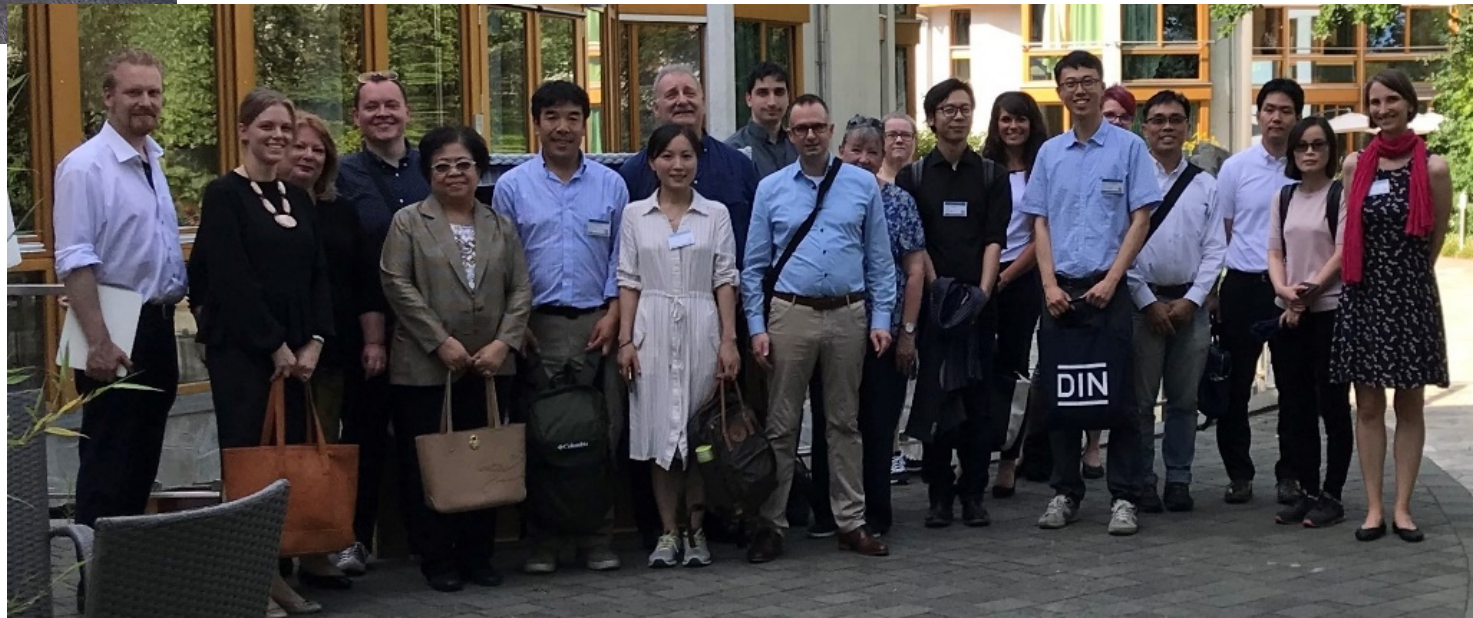
